Estimated Cost of OEM Service Contracts

Typical OEM Service Contract Costs for Annual PM/Calibration, 8-5, M-F, Travel, Labor, Parts, 90 Day Service Warranty, 24x7 phone support.

ProVis/Mark V Plus	\$2500 per injector/year
Envision	\$2000 per injector/year
Stellant D	\$3500 per injector/year
Spectris Solaris EP	\$2500 per injector/year

Total Estimated Cost of Annual Service Contracts = \$19,500
(Assumes service contracts on three ProVis', two Stellant Ds and two Spectris Solaris')

Cost of Injector Training

Per Model - \$1300*

Test Equipment (total, not per model) - \$1600 or \$2400

Total cost of test equipment determined by which model injectors you get trained on.

Savings Attained with Training

Assuming you have seven injectors at your facility under contract and you get one tech trained to maintain all seven, your savings on those service contracts would be roughly:

\$14,100 the first year
\$21,000 each year after that
